Minutes of Meeting

First meeting of Governor's Advisory Board was convened on 22.08.2020 under Chairmanship of Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan. Members of Advisory Board, Secretary to Governor Sh. Subir Kumar, Principal OSD to Governor Sh. Govind Ram Jaiswal, Director (Tribal Welfare) & Joint Secretary to Governor Dr. Kavita Singh and Controller Sh. Sanjeev Kumar Sharma participated in meeting through video conferencing. The list of participates is enclosed at Annexure 'A'.

Member Secretary of the Advisory Board provided a brief introduction of all the members of advisory board.

Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan welcomed all members of Advisory Board in meeting and invited their suggestions regarding sustainable development of the State.

During the meeting the main observations are as follows:-

1. Dr. Vishvapati Trivedi

(Skill Development and employment Generation in Rajasthan)

Rajsathan State has road network of 2.2 Lakh km, highest national highways road length, 40% of freight corridor and 6 economic corridors passes through the State. Above facts shows that state has immense potential in field of logistics, warehousing, packaging and transportation and can help in addressing unemployment problem.

Recommendations: (Raj Bhawan and State Government)

- Skill development in end to end logistics programme on export procedures.
- Logistics course to be included in University curriculum in Rajasthan Skill Development University.
- Inclusion of logistic course in State and Centre run skill development schemes.
- Development of Rajasthan State logistic Policy for efficient supply chain within and between markets.
- Creation of Rajasthan Apex Skill Development Centre for logistics



2. Dr. Rakesh Kumar

(Public Health, Special Education and Development of tribal area)

In Rajasthan 35% of girls are married before 18 years of age, this leads to malnutrition in child and mother and increase in IMR and MMR. Communicable diseases, malaria deaths, T.B. and non communicable disease load is more in tribal districts of State.

Recommendations: (Raj bhawan and State Government)

- Focus on girls child education and ensure education atleast till 18 year of age.
- Provision of delivery facility by trained staff at hospital subcentres.
- Provision of good quality antenatal care facility.
- Focus on nutrition of pregnant mother and child for 1000 days (ie 9 month + 2 years)
- Awareness regarding breast feeding with in one hour of delivery.
- Special training programme for paramedical and nursing staff and posting them in tribal area to meet demand of medical staff in field.
- Creation of Public Health cadre in lines with Maharastra, Tamil Nadu and Kerala.
- For Special Need Children: provision in schools to identify and work on focus area and to bring them in mainstream.

3. Sh. R.N. Mathur (Legal Literacy)

Recommendations: (Raj bhawan and State Government)

- Making citizens aware of fundamental duties and fundamental rights by involving Universities.
- In tribal areas measures should be taken to prevent child labour.
- Utilization of funds available in DMFT for betterment of local people by upgrading health, employment and basic infrastructure facility.
- Inclusion of following courses in curriculum: fundamental rights, duties, women empowerment, public property protection.
- Conversation / Talk show on Doordarshan On topic of "स्वस्थ भारत स्वस्थ नागरिक" and topic relate to Covid pandemic.
- For MBBS students 6 months village posting should be made mandatory.

4. Sh. T. Murlidharan

(MSME and employment generation)

Recommendations: (State Government)

- Creating Sectoral clusters for domestic and export markets with commerce giants and export houses at centre.
- Introduction of skill wage incentive for MSME in Rajasthan on lines of Government of Goa.
- Study of Rajasthan MSME performance and sustainability pre and post Covid.
- For skill development and employment, emphasis should be given to placement of Graduate and Non Graduate separately.
- Job fair, education and skill development should be designed based on demand.
- Salary Vs Savings
- · Facility of skill hostels.
- · MSME job fairs.
- · Separate ministry for MSME.
- Scope of MSME exports.

5. Sh. Vivek Singh

(Development of Social Sector through Social Entrepreneurship and CSR)

A detailed presentation was given, scope to develop Jaipur, Ajmer, Kota, Udaipur and other identified place as important hub to trigger Social innovation and entrepreneurship. One of largest incubation Centre is at Udaipur. Action plan for first 6 months and 1 year with deliverables was presented. There is ample scope in agriculture and water conservation.

6. Dr. A.K. Gahlot

(Higher Education)

There are 27 Universities with strength of 27 Lakh students.

Recommendations: (Raj bhawan)

- Universities should work towards financial sustainability by constitution of resource generation cell, development of corpus fund, taking measures for revenue generation.
- · Universities should formulate

- Revenue generation road map upto year 2050
- Pension liability calculation upto year 2050
- All Universities to form committee to devise strategy for implementation of National Education Policy 2020.

7. Dr. Manoranjan Sharma

(Framework for integrated Development on the basis of available resources in the State)

There is immense scope in field of agriculture, animal husbandry, MSME, watershed development in the State which should be explored by elaborate discussion.

Based on above deliberation Hon'ble Governor sir directed for detailed discussion and preparation of road map for implementation of suggestion. Meeting ended with thanks to the Chair by Member Secretary.
