The Government of India has setup the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) with the objective to promote a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship in India. AIM has announced the launch of the second call for applications for Atal Incubation Centres (AICs).

I request you to spread the word about this program as widely as possible and encourage your affiliated institutes to apply.

The AICs would nurture innovative start-up businesses in their pursuit to become scalable and sustainable enterprises by providing them with a host of resources, facilities and mentoring. They would be established to support enterprises in nationally relevant sectors such as manufacturing, transport, energy, health, education, agriculture, water and sanitation etc.

In 2016-17, AIM has supported a total of 10 universities and public and private organisations to set up AICs. Learning from the last year, we are placing a special focus on applications with industry-academia collaborations. Successful applicants would be eligible to receive the grant-in-aid of up to Rs. 10 crore for establishing a new AIC over a period of 5 years, which can be spent towards capital investment or operational and maintenance expenses.
